

ELIGIBILITY, REFERRALS and PARTICIPATION

Assistance League's Operation Healthy Teeth program provides urgent dental care for underprivileged children pre-K through the 12th grade. Eligible children must not be enrolled in a private, public or other charitable program. We make a charitable contribution on behalf of the child directly to the dentist. Typically, dentists contribute their time and Assistance League covers overhead expenses. Assistance League will pay up to \$1,000.00 per child per year from the date of the first visit. In cases where extensive treatment or sedation is required, we may be able to exceed \$1,000. These cases are evaluated on a case by case basis with the dentist.

We accept referrals from schools, Give Kids A Smile, Sealants for Smiles, Head Start, other qualified agencies and dental professionals.

Dentists and Assistance League sign a simple Agreement that can be terminated by either party with notice. (PDF AGREEMENT)

AUTHORIZATION and SCHEDULING

Dentists accept referrals at their discretion. Once a child is accepted in the program, the parent/guardian will contact your office directly to schedule an appointment and will provide the Assistance League authorization number. A Confirmation for Contribution form will be presented to you at the first visit.
