Nominations for Public Awards and Recognitions Policy

Assistance League of Salt Lake City honors those in the community who, through major and significant financial, in-kind, or service support, have had a direct, consistent and positive effect on chapter programs or activities thus warranting recognition. The award/recognition may not be given more than once per fiscal year to the same individual or group.

Procedure

- Chapter committees and auxiliaries may submit motions for nomination of an individual or group for a public award or recognition with accompanying written justification to the Board of Directors.
- Requestor shall receive timely notice from the President of approval or rejection of the nomination.
- If the nomination is approved, the President shall:
 - direct the Communications Committee to produce the award/recognition
 - announce the award/recognition at the next Regular Meeting
 - work with the requestor and the Communications Committee to arrange for presentation of the award or recognition
 - write a congratulatory letter to the recipient
